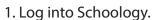
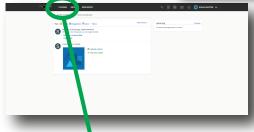


Step 1: Teacher creates assignment in Schoology



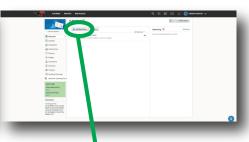




2. Choose COURSES.

5. Choose your **Lone Star Learning Plus.**

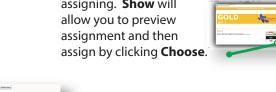


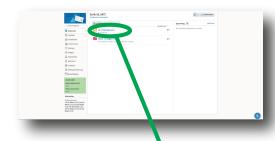
6. Choose the set you wish to assign.

Step 2: Student receives the assignment. Students will be notified in Schoology and will also receive an email notification that they have a new assignment.







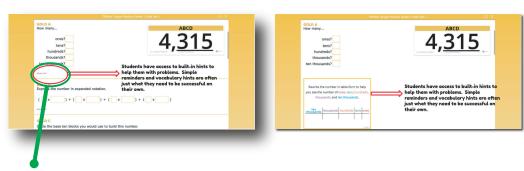
2. Choose Course.

Step 3: Teacher reviews work and gives feedback

1. Log into Schoology.

3. You are now in the Grades and Reporting dashboard.



4. Click here.



5. View overall summary. (Work requiring teacher feedback will record as 0/1 until graded by the teacher.)



6. Click on the question if you want to grade question by question.



7. Click on the name of the student if you want to grade student by student.



8. Student's work will open. Results can be found beside each question. Questions with a yellow triangle are questions the teacher needs to review and score.



9. Send the grades to Schoology and to the student. Close when you're finished. (upper right)



10. View grades in Gradebook.

1. Log into Schoology.



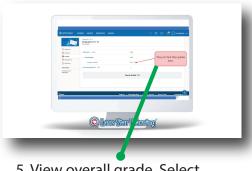
2. Student receives notification for feedback in Schoology and email.
